Re: UPDATE NEWSLETTER IN PREPARATION FOR HOSTEL HOME WEEKEND

With the home weekend of September 29 – October 1 weekend fast approaching, we would like to make you aware of the following points relevant to your child's schooling in need of your attention.

1. **Hostel home weekend:** Please be reminded that our hostel closes on Friday September 29 at 2:00 pm and re-opens again at 12:00 Noon Sunday October 1. The hostel will be locked down during this time and it is important that you pick up your child before the 2:00 pm time September 29 Friday. Should you need to pick your child up before the 12:00 noon time marking the end of classes on that day, it will be fine to do so, but please contact the school in advance should this be your plan. Please also be aware that the school hostel **ONLY** opens again after 12H: 00 pm Sunday October 1, so please do not attempt to bring your child before then as there may be no one at the hostel to receive him.
2. **Educational field trip Friday October 6th:** On Friday October 6, all students will be transported to Benny's Park in Ongwediva as part of their education in community integration. We ask that you provide N\$50 to cover expenses for each of your attending children in order to cover the park entry fee as well as food and drinks. This fee can be brought along when your child is returned to Hostel on October 1, or be directly deposited in the school bank account with "Oct 6 field trip" written in the reference field.
3. **Mosquito nets, toilet paper, and Ariel/OMO laundry soap:** For all hostel children, it is important you bring a new mosquito net for covering your child's bed at night. Although we spray for controlling mosquitoes regularly, the existing nets are becoming worn and need replacing. Please ensure to bring a new net as well as the usual supply of toilet paper and OMO laundry soap along on your return to hostel October 1.
